



CCMC Flood Control Project Steering Committee

The **CCMC Flood Control Project Steering Committee** met Thursday, September 10, 2020, at 3:30 p.m. meeting took place over zoom. Present were Committee Members Floodplain Administrator (FPA) Samantha Malenovsky, Grant Writer Ally Capps, Custer County Commissioner (CC) Jason Strouf, and Chris Fassero with the USACE. Absent were Public Works Director (PWD) Scott Gray, (KLJ) Carl Jackson, and (KLJ) Becky Bey.

FPA Malenovsky stated that the Section 205 commenced in late May. She asked Mr. Fassero to give an update on where the project had left off and what was planned for the future.

Mr. Fassero noted that before the postponement of the Section 205 study the USACE and the community had just developed levee sections. When the project started back up quantity estimates were developed for those segments with an assumed levee width based on a design height and assumed side slope. Cost estimates are being ran on these segments with the potential to have the estimates completed by October.

By the end of the year the USACE would like to have a potential meeting with the community staff to discuss the cost estimates and segments and work on refining any unknown variables that arose during the initial evaluation. The “without project” will be compared with these segments to determine what would be affordable given the economic analysis.

By the end of calendar year 2021 these alternatives will be narrowed down to select a recommended alternative with the study potentially being completed by federal fiscal year 2022.
